Impacts to Healthcare Professionals

Enables Government to:

- Conduct warrantless search and seizure of property of health offices, s. 511, 506, 1a-d
- Only Government appointees on Colleges & Boards, s. 345, 346, 486
- Dictate healthcare services with unprecedented power,
 s. 222
- Demand access to private clinical records, s. 131, 224
- Adopt regulation codes from foreign countries,
 s. 335, 533
- Issue **fines up to \$200,000** and/or **imprisonment up to 6 months** for 'misleading information' not in agreement with government, s. 34, 518, a, b, c

Impacts to Public

- Staff shortages Health providers leaving BC
- **E.R.** shutdowns
- Long wait times increased health risk
